



When the letters are in the right order, they will spell a word.




# The caring shepherd

He knew and loved each one of them.










Everyday he took his sheep out on to the hills to find grass for them to eat. It was tiring work.










When he returned home, the shepherd counted his sheep back into the fold as usual, but on this day he only got to 99! The shepherd was horrified. One of his precious sheep was missing.








The shepherd left the other 99 and went out into the night, determined to find the sheep who was lost before a wolf found it!












After he had walked many miles, he heard a faint cry. The shepherd followed the sound and, to his relief, found the sheep trapped but unharmed.




























### Reflecting

Would their teacher say...


It doesn't matter, let them go, we still have the rest of the class.
